


PILGRIMS OF HOPE


ON A JOURNEY OF HOPE TO THE MANGER

In this passage, the writer remembers God's love and faithfulness in difficult times. How can you remind yourself of God's love and hope, especially when life feels hard or uncertain?


What are some ways you can embrace God's compassion and share that hope with others during Advent?
